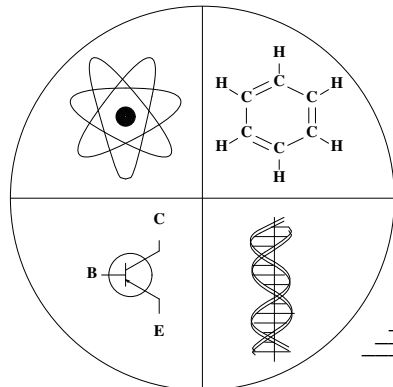

Saturday, March 25
