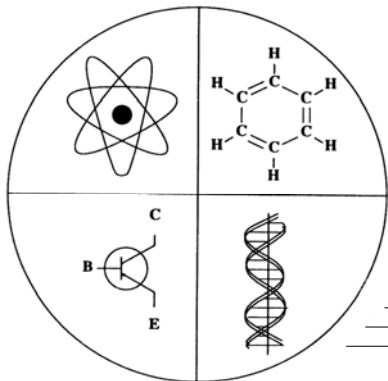

We understand that the student is expected to prepare a ten-minute oral presentation of this project for use in the Finalist Symposium, in the event the project is chosen as a finalist for the ISEF awards.
